- ◆ First public reading of The Declaration of Independence, July 8, 1776, by Col. John Nixon. His house that day later became the servants wing of Physick House. Young Philip Syng Physick and classmates playing in the woods behind the State House missed the reading that day.

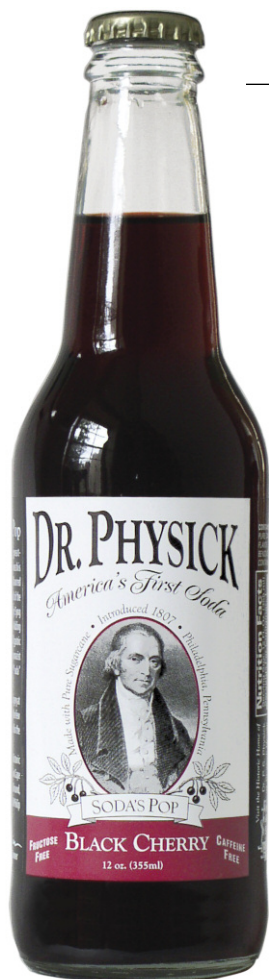
- ◆ Signing of The Declaration of Independence on August 2, 1776 using the inkstand made by Physick’s grandfather silver-smith Philip Syng.



- ◆ Cracking of the Liberty Bell on July 8, 1835 while tolling for the funeral procession of Dr. Physick’s patient Chief Justice John Marshall.
